About the Label: On January 16, 1944, thousands of Texans serving in the Pacific gathered at Ala Moana Park in Honolulu for the "Old Texas Roundup," held in honor of Fredericksburg native Admiral Chester Nimitz. The label depicts Admiral Nimitz addressing the crowd. The event served as a vital boost to morale and fighting spirit—just one year before Allied victory in the Pacific.

Flavors of blackberry while oak aging adds balanced layers of black tea.

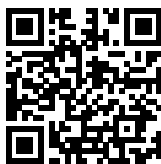
