Messina Hof is honored to craft and showcase a wine collection for the ages that pays respect to the brave men and women that served during World War II and specifically in support of the Pacific War operations.

About the Label: Operation Iceberg was the Allied invasion of Okinawa, a strategically vital island just a few hundred miles from mainland Japan. On Easter morning, April 1, 1945, more than 1,300 ships and over 500,000 Allied troops launched the largest amphibious assault of World War II — a brutal battle that raged until June 22 with immense casualties on both sides.

NOSE

This light-bodied wine is bright and austere with enticing bursts of grapefruit and pineapple.

PALATE

Wisps of lemongrass on the nose.

The crisp notes refresh, delight, and complement warm weather and seafood.
