

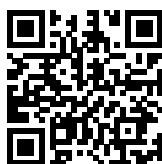

ABOUT THIS WINE

This Spanish varietal is well known in Texas. Our 2021 Tempranillo is a more restrained and savory expression of Tempranillo - a bit Old World. This vintage opens with aromas of red plum, dried cherry, and sunbaked earth, layered with notes of wild herbs, tobacco leaf, and a distinctive hint of cured meat. On the palate, the wine is medium-bodied and structured, emphasizing freshness and balance over weight. Bright red fruit is framed by earthy, herbal tones—think dried thyme and sage—interwoven with hints of leather and savory spice.

TASTING NOTES

NOSE

This vintage opens with aromas of red plum, dried cherry, and sunbaked earth, layered with notes of wild herbs, tobacco leaf, and a distinctive hint of cured meat. Subtle influences of French and American oak lend nuances of cedar, spice, and a touch of vanilla without overshadowing the wine's natural character.

PALATE

On the palate, the wine is medium-bodied and structured, emphasizing freshness and balance over weight. Bright red fruit is framed by earthy, herbal tones—think dried thyme and sage—interwoven with hints of leather and savory spice. Fine, persistent tannins and vibrant acidity carry through to a long, dry finish marked by lingering notes of red fruit, mineral undertones, and a gentle, smoky savoriness.
